



Mr. Masee and Marshal Patterson both spoke to the issue of possible amendments to the Animal Control Code. It was their pinion that the only additions needed were an updated schedule for fees pertaining to impoundment of animals, spaying and neutering, etc. Marshal Patterson will submit a recommended schedule for Council consideration.

5. THE COUNCIL MAY NOT DISCUSS, DELIBERATE OR TAKE ANY ACTION ON THE SUBSTANCE OF THE TOPICS OTHER THAN TO VOTE TO INCLUDE THEM ON A FUTURE AGENDA. A.R.S. §38- 431.02(H).

Mayor Isakson recognized Ray Klein who spoke about the possibility of the Town adopting a provision giving local businesses preference in purchasing and contracting decisions. Mr. Masee will draft a provision for discussion and possible consideration by Mayor and Council.
