*Mimulus guttatus* - monkey flower  
*Imperata brevifolia* - satintail grass  
*Aquilegia chrysantha* - columbine  
*Bouvardia ternifolia* - firecracker bush  
*Datura wrightii* - sacred datura  
*Penstemon palmeri* - palmer's penstemon  
*Muhlenbergia porteri* - bush muhly  
*Sporobolus wrightii* - Giant Sacaton  
*Bouteloua gracilis* - blue grama
